The Methodist Hospitals Rehabilitation Institute was privileged to assist 456 patients last year in returning back their function. Rehabilitation Institute's comprehensive integrated rehabilitation program includes physical therapy, occupational therapy, and/or speech therapy, as well as recreational therapy. In addition, the patient is supported by nursing case management, social workers, a registered dietician, psychologist, physiatrist, (a physician who specializes in physical and rehabilitation medicine) and 24-hour rehabilitation nursing.

Scope of Service

As a patient of Rehabilitation Institute, an individualized interdisciplinary treatment plan will be developed based on your medical, physical, nutritional, functional, spiritual, psychological and cultural needs.


Patients admitted to the Rehabilitation Institute:


- Must meet the criteria for an Inpatient Rehab Facility
- Goals for discharge will be set in collaboration with the rehab team
- Must be willing and able to participate in 3 hours per day of physical, occupational, and/or speech therapy
 5 to 7 days per week

Each referral is reviewed on an individual basis. Methodist Hospitals' Rehabilitation Institute is unable to serve patients who are ventilator dependent, comatose, under the age of 18, or requiring suicide precautions or physical restraints.
